Subject: European Directive 2011/65/EC of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS, recast) with Annex II amended by delegated directive (EU) 2015/863, its delegated directives and amended by the directive 2017/2102/EC.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The European Directives cited above restrict the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants, as well as the substances Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) in the equipment listed in annex I of the directive.

BACO, a brand of Legrand's Group, seeks to go further than the regulation and in the aim of environmental protection and has therefore decided to eliminate the substances covered by this directive from all its products

All products falling within the scope of the directive are in conformity since March 1st, 2015.

For the products outside the scope, the Legrand Group seeks to stay ahead of regulations. The substances targeted are due to be gradually removed from our products.

We planned this action on these products according to their renewal, their technical nature and our customers' requirements.
